

Cycling in Small Town America

Sharon, Wisconsin Facts

Settled in 1841, and established in 1856, Sharon has a population of 1,580. It is centrally located along the southern Wisconsin State Line. It is between the cities of Rockford and Chicago, IL and Madison and Milwaukee, WI. Sharon retains its small town charm while offering great cycling country. The network of rural roads through this area is perfect for summertime cycling, especially with the opportunity to stop for refreshments at three small town ice cream shops along the way.

The Tour

The Roun'da Manure Bicycle Tour is a one-day bicycle tour through pastoral farmlands and friendly towns and includes:

- A choice of three different marked routes (17, 27, and 44 miles)
- Five free coupons, redeemable at local ice cream shops along your chosen route
- A Pig Roast Luncheon at the conclusion of your ride- swap bike tales with fellow cyclists while enjoying a home cooked summertime meal!

Safety

Routes are on public roads and must be shared with motor vehicles. We require all riders to wear helmets, ride single file, and obey all traffic laws. All riders should carry a spare tube, pump, and water. Please make sure your brake and shift cables are not rusted as well! We will provide mechanical support if necessary. All riders must be off the road by 5:00 PM. The Village of Sharon hopes you enjoy visiting their downtown and area countryside.

Registration

You may choose to register on the day of the event, or pre-register (with the attached form) by August 4th. If you pre-register in a group of 3 or more, you will receive a discount on the event hat, as well as a free water bottle. Please compile all forms into one envelope to receive the group discount.

17-mile loop registration is from 9:00-10:00 AM only

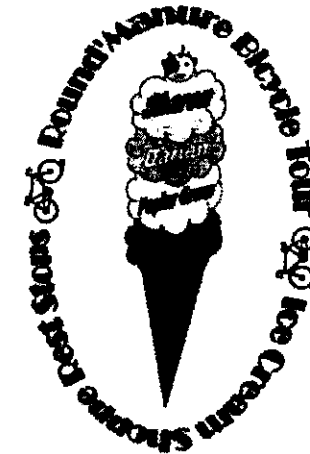
